

## Guidelines for Daycare/Youth Groups

The following guidelines have been established to accommodate the daycares/youth groups of Terrell. These rules are to be strictly enforced in all situations to ensure the safest atmosphere for the daycares/youth groups and other pool patrons.

1. All daycares/youth groups intending to use the Terrell City Pool during open swim hours must make arrangements with the Pool Manager at least 48 hours prior to visit.
2. Each group must have a ratio of one (1) chaperon (adult 18 years or older) per ten (10) youth.
3. Chaperones must be present and prepared to enter the pool to assist in situations involving their group.
4. One person is responsible for the entire group and must register with the Pool Manager before entering the pool.
5. No floats, arm floats, toys or balls, etc. are allowed in the pool area. Life jackets will be available for use for all non-swimmers.
6. Groups will not be allowed to monopolize any area of the pool.
7. The Pool Manager, Lifeguard, or Aquatic Staff reserve the right to Swim Test any participant to determine their ability to swim in the deep end or use the diving boards.
8. Supervising adults will be required to watch the members of their group in swim suits.
9. Payment is due at the time of use and may be paid by check made payable to the "City of Terrell". Fees will follow all open swim admission fees. Non-Profit Organizations will be charged half price.
10. At the top of each hour when the 10 minute Break/Adult swim is activated {Daycares/Youth groups will do a buddy check to account for all children/youth in their group}
